HB1080 - An act to prohibit doctors from prescribing puberty blockers and cross sex hormones or performing genital surgery on minors.

HB1092 - An act to redefine marriage as being between "two persons."

HJR5006 - A resolution to place on the ballot the question of sports betting on mobile devices.

HB1157 - An act to require that state advertising dollars be used to communicate the negative effects of compulsive gambling.

SB75 - An act to clarify that child support obligations with regard to pregnancy expenses begin at conception.

SB117 - An act to increase the video lottery bet limit and winning potential.

SCR602 - A resolution expressing support for the Dobbs decision from the Supreme Court.

HB1225 - An act to allow for a pregnant minor to give consent for certain treatments.

HB1233 - An act to allow for the option of virtual schooling.

HB1163 - An act to require that libraries adopt a policy prohibiting minors from accessing explicit materials.

HB1116 - An act to clarify that state resources will not be used for explicit performances, and that institutions have the authority to place age restrictions on events.

SB193 - An act to require that schools adopt a policy allowing for review of new materials and review of potentially explicit materials.

SB57 - An act to prohibit homeschool students from open-enrolling for extra-curricular activities.
